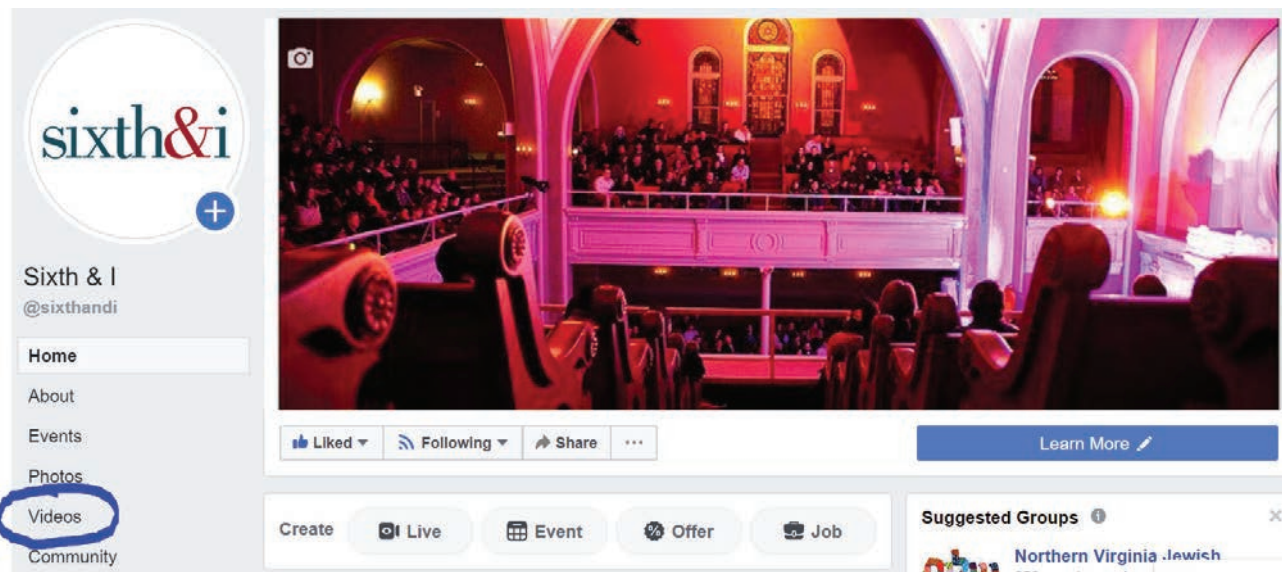

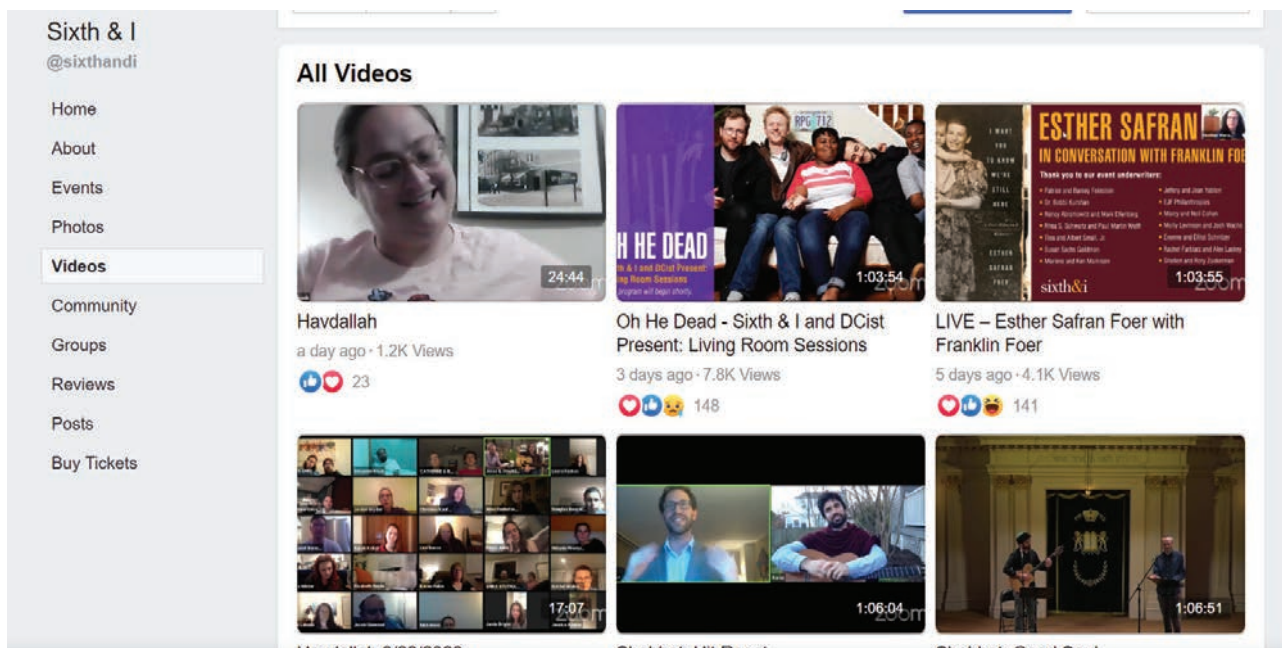
facebook live-streams

1. Navigate to our Facebook page at www.facebook.com/sixthandi
2. In the left-hand toolbar, click **Videos**:
