

Accessible Entry and Seating

Parking and Transportation

- For directions, visit our website here.
- Sixth & I does not have a parking lot.
- Attendee drop-off is located at 606 I Street NW.
- PMI's garage at 600 Massachusetts Avenue NW is wheelchair-accessible.
 - o Park near the elevator that directs to the Karma restaurant.
 - Exit on the lobby level and cross the street to enter Sixth & I's building.

Building Access

- Unless otherwise noted, general admission entry is on 6th Street NW through our Box Office.
- Our lift outside of our building at 606 I Street NW will provide direct access (avoiding all stairs) to the main level of the Sanctuary.
 - The lift can only operate if one person uses the lift at a time.
 - The lift is approximately 58.5 inches long and 33 inches wide (31 inches at waist height, including the handle)
 - Our lifts also operate to and from the Social Hall and Main Sanctuary levels.
- We recommend entering at 606 I Street NW:
 - If you prefer to not stand for longer periods of time
 - If you prefer to not walk long distances
 - o If you prefer the least amount of stairs to access the building
- We strongly encourage you to allow extra time for your arrival, as staff may be assisting other attendees.
- We are available starting one hour before each event begins to assist you in getting from the front of the building to your preferred entrance.
 - We will then check you into the event and assist you to your seat or wheelchair-accessible location.
 - At breaks, we will check in with you if you need assistance getting to restroom entrances or the Social Hall level.
 - At the conclusion of the event, we will be available to assist you to the wheelchair lift or the front of the building.
- We are not permitted to assist you in transferring to or from a wheelchair, your seat in the Sanctuary, nor any vehicle.
- We are not permitted to operate motorized mobility aids such as scooters and Segways.
- We are not permitted to provide personal attendant services such as assisting you in the restroom, with taking medications, or with similar activities.
- We are not permitted to accompany you outside of the building beyond the lift exit in the front of our building.

Restroom Access

- The single-occupancy restroom on our main level is the first door on the left after the entrance at 606 I Street NW.
- The single-occupancy restroom on the Social Hall level, one floor below the main level, is in the middle of the Social Hall hallway.
- On the second floor classroom, when you exit the elevator, turn right and then right again before the doors to the staircase to access the single-occupancy restroom.
- On the fourth floor classroom, when you exit the elevator, turn right and then right again before the doors to the staircase to access the single-occupancy restroom.



Sanctuary Access

- We offer the same wheelchair-accessible seating options for all ticketed attendees at all ticket price levels.
- Unless otherwise noted, all events and services are general admission seating in the Sanctuary's fixed pews.
- Accessible seating options are available on a first-come, first-served basis.
 - o If you prefer the shortest distance to your seat, we have seating in the back row of the main level of the Sanctuary.
 - o If you prefer a size-inclusive seat, we have seating in the front row on the main level of the Sanctuary that includes extra legroom.
 - o If you are using a mobility aid, we have free-standing chairs with and without arms on the main level of the Sanctuary that can be moved and removed as needed.
 - Wheelchair-accessible locations start at 40 square feet, but can be adjusted for more space and/or a larger turning radius as needed.
 - o Please contact Amanda in advance to note what seating option works best for you to ensure this is reserved for easy access on the day of the event.
- For every accessible seat reservation, we can also reserve up to 3 seats in the same row, contiguous with your seat or wheelchair-accessible location.
- Personal Attendants
 - o If you have a disability and cannot fully access our building without the help of a personal attendant, we will waive the cost of your personal attendant's ticket.
 - o In these circumstances, we recommend that you contact Amanda in advance to note this complimentary request.

Classroom Access

- Our elevator at the 606 I Street NW entrance provides access to all classroom floors.
- Seating in classrooms include moveable chairs.
