SIXTH & I DAY

APRIL 22, 2024

WHEREAS, the Sixth & I Historic Synagogue is a nondenominational and nontraditional Jewish congregation and synagogue founded 20 years ago at the corner of Sixth and I Streets in Chinatown; and

WHEREAS, housed within a revitalized edifice dating back to 1908, the Sixth & I synagogue reimagines how culture, community, and Jewish life can enhance the everyday lives of all; and

WHEREAS, Sixth & I is a treasured resource that enriches the District of Columbia with dynamic world-class arts and entertainment experiences that fuel curiosity, encourage new perspectives, and spark inspiration; and

WHEREAS, by celebrating the intersections of culture and spirituality, the Sixth & I Synagogue expands our sense of what is sacred; and

WHEREAS, recognizing "Sixth & I Day" is an homage to the synagogue's enormous impact on the lives of District residents and visitors:
